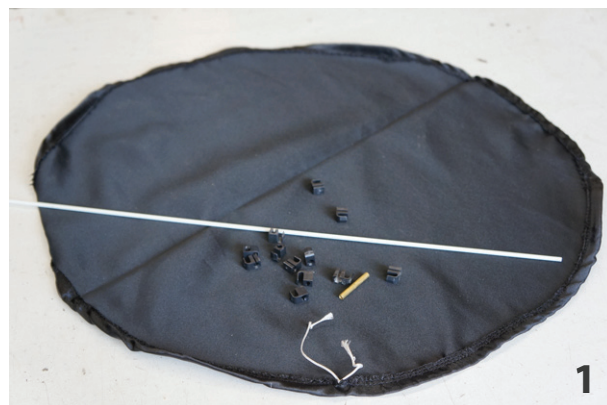


Wheel cover assemble



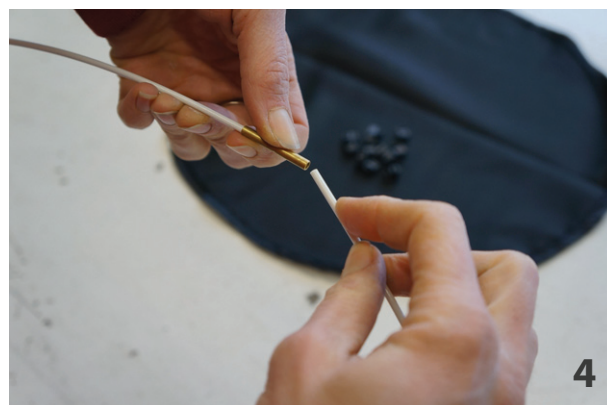
- wheel cover
- glassfibre rod
- brass tube
- spoke clips
- scissors



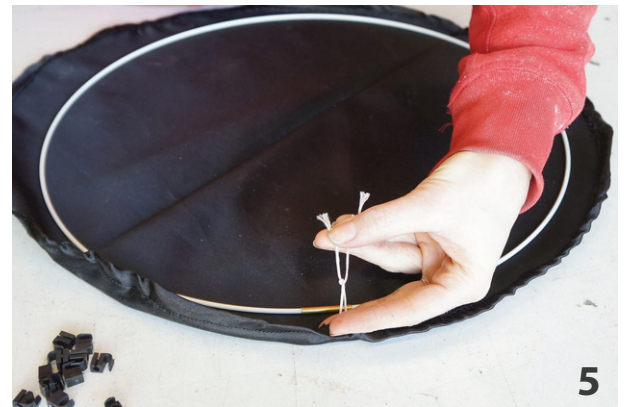
Start by mounting the clips on the spokes. (pic 2 and 3)
One every fourth spoke. Use the spokes on the side where the wheel cover will come.



Now join the rod-ends together in the brass tube (pic 4).
See if the hoop fits nicely in the clips. If necessary, shorten the rod bit. Measure this exact. A too short rod will vibrate in the clips and then the fabric will wear quickly.



Pull the string out at the opening and leave one knot in (pic 5).



Tighten that knot, so the fabric has a good tension. The hoop should remain flat (pic 6).



Pull the hoop against your waist and hold the strings with one hand, so the free hand can make a second knot without losing tension. Then make a third knot. (pic 7)



After laying the knots the tension should not decrease.

If this succeeded you can cut the string 5 cm after the knots.

Lay the wheel cover in the clips (pic 8).



For the last clip you have to push in the hoop. Done!
